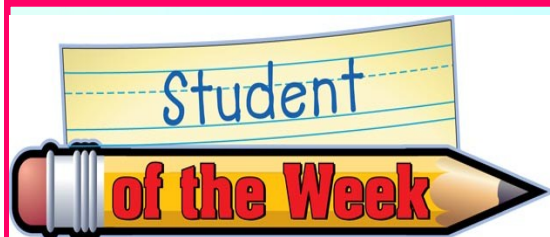
The students displayed excellent behaviour and manners and thoroughly enjoyed this experience.
