Please read over these together so that you and your child/ren are familiar with them.




### 'GARDENING BEE' AT APEX PARK

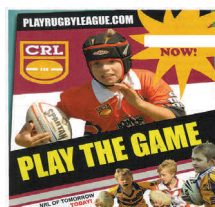
