Please make sure students have a water bottle, a hat and jumper/jacket in case it is cold.

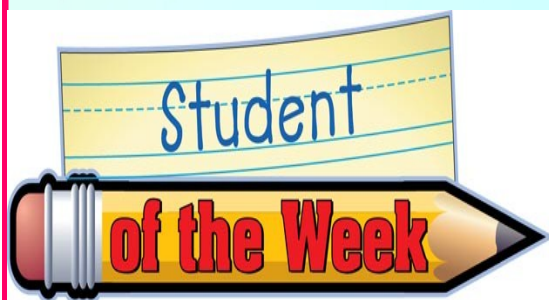
We are expecting to return to school at 5pm. Please ensure students permission notes with payment of \$15per student are handed in to the school office prior to Thursday.

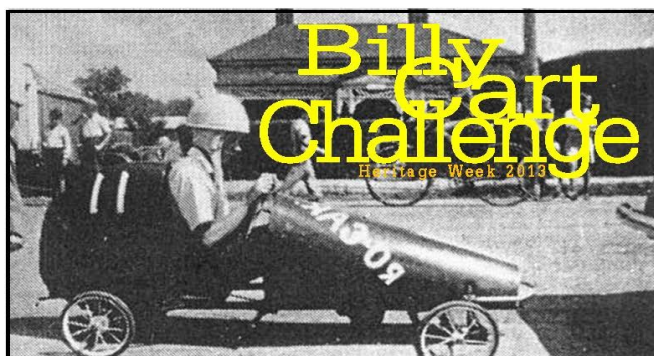
