In week 3 (next week), students in Years 3 & 5 will be completing NAPLAN tests in the areas of Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Numeracy.

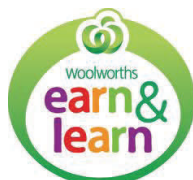
