Students will be able to order lunch orders from the central.

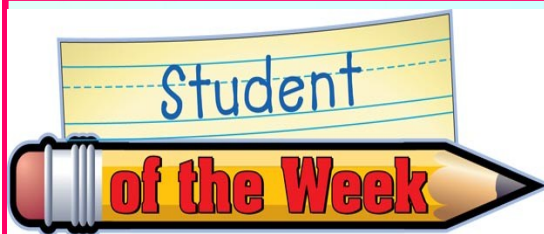

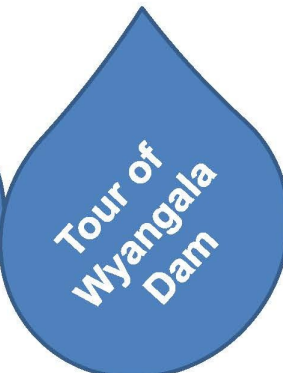
