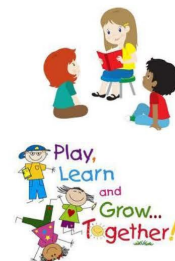

Teachers are able to walk students back to the Preschool if required.

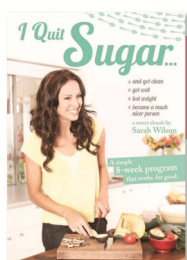
