Don't forget to purchase your tickets for the Melbourne Cup Luncheon at Eat Your Greens. Final ticket numbers are needed by Friday 31st October.

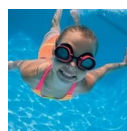

INTENSIVE SWIMMING



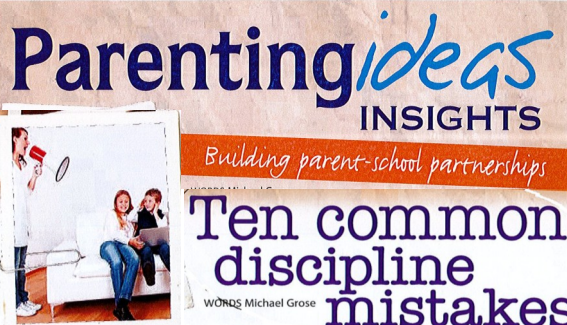
During week 6 and week 7 of this term (10th Nov to 21st Nov) all students will be participating in an intensive learn to swim or swimming

Here are 10 common and easily avoided mistakes parents make when disciplining their children. Replace these mistakes with better techniques and you'll be on your way to parenting easy street.


3 Setting limits too late
