INTENSIVE SWIMMING

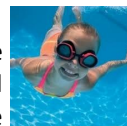

The P & C have donated a generous \$2000 towards the cost of the bus to transport the students daily to the pool. The school will fund the pool entry fees.


Permission notes have been sent home. These need to be returned by TOMORROW, Thursday 5th November 2014.
