Bedgerebong Public School disco will be held again this year at the Bedgerebong Hall on Thursday June 5.

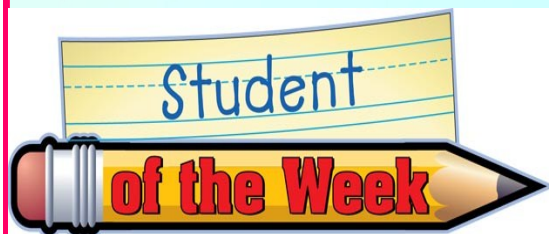
Eugowra students are invited to attend this event.
