SIMULTANEOUS READING DAY

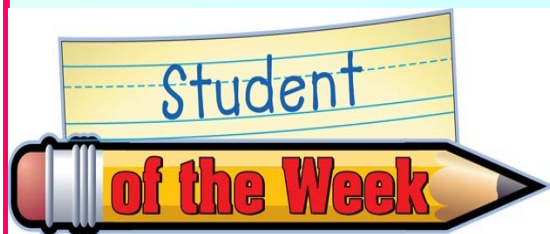
Today, Wed 21st May students celebrated National Simultaneous Reading Day.
