### What is the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse?

The Royal commission has been set up to investigate child sexual abuse that has taken place in institutions like schools, churches or missions, sports clubs, orphanages, foster care and government agencies and how these institutions have responded to allegations and instances of child sexual abuse. It is the job of the Royal Commission to uncover where systems have failed to protect children so it can make recommendations on how to improve laws, policies and practices for the future.

### What can I do about it?

If you, or someone you know were sexually abused as a child while in the care of an institution in Australia, you can share your story with the Royal Commission.

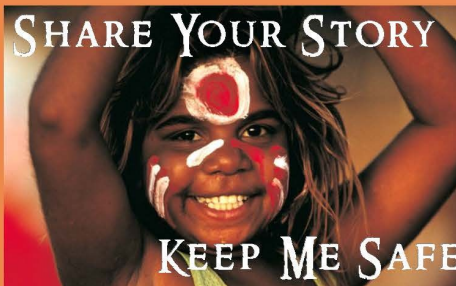
### Why Should I tell my story?

Your Story will help build a picture about what happened to children in the past, and how to better protect our children in the future.

### What is knowmore?

**knowmore** is a free legal service that provides confidential legal advice about your options for talking with the Royal Commission, and about related issues

such as confidentiality agreements and compensation. They can provide culturally safe & respectful service to anyone who seeks help

### Working with Binaal Billa Family Violence Legal Service

Binaal Billa Family Violence Legal Service has **Solicitors**, **Support Workers** and a **Counsellor** available if you need help to share your story or to cope with the feelings that you are experiencing.

We understand that sharing your story can be hard. This may be the first time you have told anyone about the abuse, or it may bring back painful memories. To help you through this we have a counsellor on board who can work with you.

How you can tell your story in private to the Royal Commission:

- ♦ Speak to them over the phone
- ♦ Write a letter
- ♦ Meet with them face to face
- ♦ Speak to them via Video link at Binaal Billa FVPLS Office
