DEBATING

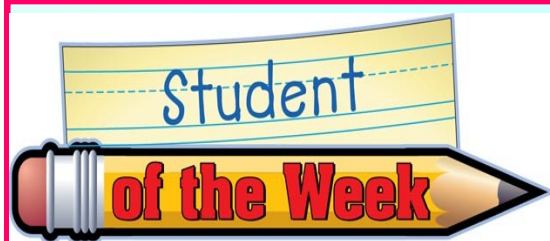

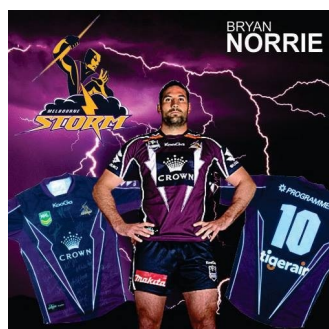
