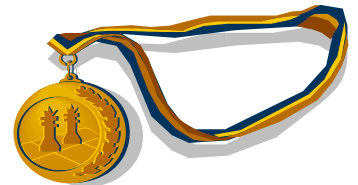
Champion Update

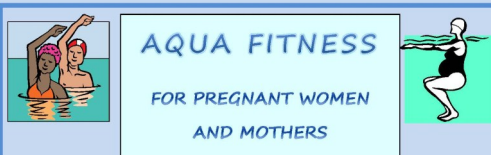
