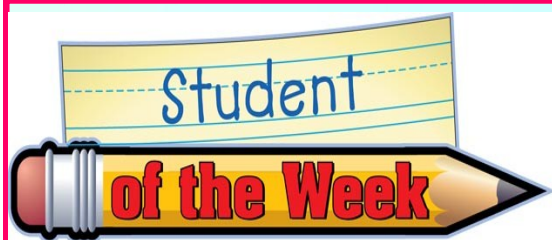

This Weeks Value:

Generosity: Giving fully, sharing freely. Trust that there is plenty for everyone. Giving or ready to give freely, free from meanness or prejudice.

Teach that happiness is in relationships not in things, and that loving relationships require self-giving. Parents mar the growth of generosity when they talk too much about their own gadgets and purchases, and when they spoil children. It is not enough that children earn their money, parents must succeed in fostering habits of detachment by living in their own lives the principle: 'We use things but we don't put our hearts in them.' Obviously it is best to avoid expensive presents creating the illusion that the more one possesses, the happier one becomes. The aim is to teach children to make use of money and material possessions to do good for those they love, and for those in need.

Teach generosity by fostering caring for those who are less fortunate. This is a timeless necessity. It is said that, 'You give little when you give of your possessions. It is when you give of yourself that you truly give.' Talk about ideals around the dinner table and then walk the walk. Work with your child in the service of others: mowing the elderly neighbour's lawn, visiting grandparents more often, dropping everything to visit a friend who has suffered a misfortune, etc.
