Start Prevention Strategies:

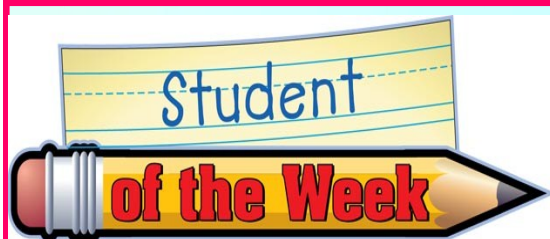
- * **Tie hair back so it is not loose i.e. plait or bun.**
